A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED CHILD EXPLOITATION AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING TASK FORCE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) BETWEEN THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION (FBI) AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK TO COMBAT HUMAN TRAFFICKING; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Part I of the Florida Statutes, the "Florida Mutual Aid Act," the Coconut Creek Police Department has the authority to enter into the attached Federal Bureau of Investigation Child Exploitation and Human Trafficking Task Force Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU"); and

WHEREAS, by entering into this MOU, the Coconut Creek Police Department will be able to share information with other Law Enforcement Agencies in Broward County and the Federal Bureau of Investigation with the purpose to identify victims of human trafficking, assist the victims, and prosecute the perpetrators of the human trafficking.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

- <u>Section 1:</u> That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.
- <u>Section 2:</u> That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the Child Exploitation and Human Trafficking Task Force MOU, attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A," between the FBI and the City of Coconut Creek.
- <u>Section 3:</u> That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the Child Exploitation and Human Trafficking Task Force MOU between the FBI and the City of Coconut Creek.
- **Section 4:** That if any clause, section, other part, or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in
