

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-175**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SHARING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BROWARD SHERIFF'S OFFICE (BSO) AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK TO PROVIDE FOR CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION RECORDS TO BE ELECTRONICALLY SHARED BETWEEN BSO AND THE COCONUT CREEK POLICE DEPARTMENT (CCPD); PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Coconut Creek Police Department (CCPD) and the Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO) are both criminal justice agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, BSO maintains records through an electronic management system, which creates and stores offense reports referred to as Criminal Justice Information (CJI); and

**WHEREAS**, the CCPD wishes to receive CJI from BSO for the efficient administration of criminal justice; and

**WHEREAS**, the CCPD agrees to abide by all terms and conditions of the Criminal Justice User Agreement executed between the Federal Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) and BSO.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1:** That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

**Section 2:** That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached Criminal Justice Information Sharing Agreement between the Broward Sheriff's Office and the City of Coconut Creek, attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A."

**Section 3:** That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said agreement.

**Section 4:** That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

**Section 5:** That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
