RESOLUTION NO. 2022-023

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE 2021 AAA FLORIDA TRAFFIC SAFETY GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO USE THE FUNDS TO PUBLICIZE THE SLOW DOWN, MOVE OVER LAW; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek applied for and was awarded the 2021 AAA Florida Traffic Safety Grant; and

WHEREAS, the grant provides Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000), which the Coconut Creek Police Department (CCPD) will use to create signage and banners that convey the important message about the "Slow Down, Move Over" law; and

WHEREAS, this law requires drivers to move over one lane as soon as it is safe to do so, for any authorized vehicles displaying visible signals while stopped on the roadside to aid motorists; and

WHEREAS, the materials will be distributed strategically throughout the City to disseminate the message effectively to the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

- **Section 1:** That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.
- **Section 2:** That the City Commission hereby accepts the 2021 AAA Florida Traffic Safety Grant in the amount of \$3,000.
- <u>Section 3:</u> That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves this grant for the purpose of aiding the Slow Down, Move Over educational campaign by creating signage and banners to publicize and distribute throughout the City.

Section 4: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to accept this grant to help save first responders' lives.

<u>Section 5:</u> That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 6: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
