A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK FOR **EMERGENCY/NONGUARANTEED** SUPPLEMENTAL SUPPORT BUILDING CODE SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED BY THE BROWARD COUNTY BUILDING CODE SERVICES DIVISION OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL **PROTECTION** AND **GROWTH** MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT: **PROVIDING** SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Broward County has been providing the City with inspection services, plan review and/or building official services since September 2, 1982, pursuant to the request of the City of Coconut Creek; and

WHEREAS, the City's current agreement with Broward County expired on September 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to continue said services provided by the County per the attached Interlocal Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

<u>Section 2:</u> That the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek, Florida, has reviewed and hereby approves the attached Interlocal Agreement between Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek providing for emergency/nonguaranteed supplemental support building code services to be performed by the Broward County Building Code Services Division of the Environmental Protection and Growth Management Department.

Section 3: That the Mayor and the City Manager, or designee, are hereby authorized to execute the attached Interlocal Agreement between Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek and, upon expiration of the Interlocal Agreement, to request an extension of the agreement if services have been satisfactory and are still required, and to accept revisions to the scope of services approved by the County Administrator, as provided in the agreement.

That the City Commission directs the City Clerk to provide a certified copy of this resolution to Broward County.

Section 5: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon Section 6: its adoption.
