

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-174

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE USE OF FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$29,700 FOR RENEWAL OF THE FLOCK SAFETY LICENSE PLATE READER (LPR) SUBSCRIPTION FOR THE FIRST YEAR OF THE FIVE (5) YEAR RENEWAL TERM; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek has established a Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the receipt and disbursement of forfeiture monies, pursuant to the Federal Department of Justice Agreement, and a Local Law Enforcement Trust Fund for receipt and disbursement of forfeiture monies, pursuant to Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has requested that the City Commission make an appropriation from the Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund; and

WHEREAS, the funds from the above request will be utilized for law enforcement purposes for the renewal of the Flock Safety License Plate Reader (LPR) subscription for the first year of the five (5) year renewal term; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation of funds complies with the requirements of the Federal Department of Justice Forfeiture Guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission hereby approves the appropriation of Twenty-Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$29,700) from the Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the renewal of the Flock Safety License Plate Reader (LPR) subscription for the first year of the five (5) year renewal term.

Section 3: That the City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to proceed with the above expenditure from forfeiture funds.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
