

Project Description

This project involves the installation of pedestrian-scale lighting along the west side sidewalk of Lyons Road to enhance safety and visibility for pedestrians, bicyclists, and public transportation users

The construction will take advantage of the underground lighting infrastructure, such as pull boxes and conduits, that were installed by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) in 2019

Project Scope

Light Pole

- Metal, dark bronze painted.
- Rounded and tapered
- 12' in height.
- Spaced at 80-ft pole to pole.
- 220 estimated number of poles

Luminaire

- Lithonia D-Series
- Model: DSX0 LED
- House Side Shield provides glare protection





Funding

Federally funded through 2023 Community Project Funding Provided by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)

Project's Funds

Grant & Contract Administration = \$390K Engineering & Inspection = \$700K Construction funds = \$2.8M


Project's total funds = \$3.9M
