

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-132

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE BROWARD COUNTY EMERGENCY ORDERS; PROVIDING FOR REIMBURSEMENT TO THE CITY FOR ENFORCEMENT FUNCTIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 8-56 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, the County and municipalities countywide are authorized to implement and enforce the provisions of Emergency Orders issued by the County including, but not limited to, Emergency Order Nos. 20-10, 20-12, 20-13, and any subsequent Emergency Orders issued by County (collectively, "Emergency Order"); and

WHEREAS, the County and the City are desirous of providing for enforcement of the Emergency Orders and Section 8-56 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances within the municipal boundaries by the City's Code Compliance Officers and for the County to provide reimbursement to the City for said enforcement functions in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the attached Interlocal Agreement (ILA); and

WHEREAS, the attached ILA provides for all terms and conditions related to the enforcement of Broward County Emergency Orders and for the County's reimbursement to the City for enforcement functions; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission find and determines it to be in the best interest of the residents of the City of Coconut Creek to enter into said ILA with Broward County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached ILA between Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek for the enforcement of Broward County Emergency Orders and for the County's reimbursement to the City for enforcement functions.

Section 3: That the Mayor and the City Manager, or designee, are hereby authorized to execute said ILA between Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
