RESOLUTION NO. 2023-029

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SHERIFF OF BROWARD COUNTY (BSO) AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, PROVIDING FOR COOPERATIVE EMERGENCY SERVICES THROUGH MUTUAL ASSISTANCE AND AUTOMATIC AID FOR FIRE-RESCUE SERVICES EFFECTIVE UPON APPROVAL BY **BOTH PARTIES AND ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2023,** WITH ONE (1) YEAR **AUTOMATIC RENEWALS**; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO RENEW THE AGREEMENT UNDER THE SAME **TERMS** AND COMMISSION CONDITIONS WITHOUT FURTHER ACTION: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek and the Broward County Sheriff's Office (hereinafter "BSO") wish to enter into an Interlocal Agreement (hereinafter "ILA") for cooperative emergency services through automatic aid for fire-rescue services, attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A;" and

WHEREAS, the geographic area for delivery of fire and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) automatic aid includes Florida's Turnpike from Broward/Palm Beach County line to Commercial Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the term of the ILA will commence upon approval by the Coconut Creek City Commission and ending on September 30, 2023, with one (1) year automatic renewals or until terminated by the parties in writing; and

WHEREAS, the parties find that mutual cooperation in the delivery of fire-rescue services can best be accomplished within a cooperative, interlocal configuration; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager, or designee, is authorized to renew the ILA under the same terms and conditions without further action by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Coconut Creek City Commission finds and determines that

entering into this ILA for cooperative emergency services through mutual assistance and automatic aid for fire-rescue services is in the best interest of the City, its residents, business owners, and visitors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1:</u> That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. The ILA, attached as Exhibit "A," is incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

<u>Section 2:</u> That the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek, Florida hereby approves the ILA between the Sheriff of Broward County (BSO) and the City of Coconut Creek, providing for cooperative emergency services through automatic aid effective upon approval by both parties and ending on September 30, 2023, with one (1) year automatic renewals unless a party notifies the other in writing, not later than sixty days (60) days prior to the expiration of this agreement or any renewal term of this agreement, of its intent not to renew.

Section 3: That the Mayor, or designee, is authorized and directed to execute the ILA on behalf of the City of Coconut Creek and forward copies to the other parties to the ILA.

Section 4: That the City Manager, or designee, is authorized to renew the ILA under the same terms and conditions without further Commission action.

<u>Section 5</u>: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 6: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
