RESOLUTION NO. 2025-103

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK AND CROM, LLC D/B/A CROM COATINGS AND RESTORATIONS (CROM) TO PROVIDE LABOR AND MATERIAL FOR THE RELINING OF THE WATER STORAGE TANK LOCATED AT 4801 HILTON ROAD; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek (City) owns and maintains a two million gallon water storage tank located at 4801 Hilton Road for the purposes of maintaining water quality for safe water consumption and water pressure for fire suppression throughout the utility service area; and

WHEREAS, the water tank liner was installed twelve (12) years ago and has surpassed its ten (10)-year useful life expectancy, causing the water tank to show signs of stress and visible water leaks; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project includes the removal of the old internal liner and the installation of a new internal liner, as well as the rehabilitation of internal parts within the water storage tank; and

WHEREAS, on May 4, 2025, the City issued Invitation for Bids (IFB) No. 05-28-25-11 for construction services related to this project; and on May 28, 2025, the bid closed with one (1) responsive and responsible bidder, CROM, LLC, in the amount of \$937,600.00, which includes Add Alternate No. 1 (surface preparation and coating of interior pipes); and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds and determines it to be in the best interest of the City to enter into an agreement with CROM, LLC d/b/a CROM Coatings and Restoration to reline the water storage tank at 4801 Hilton Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1:</u> That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

<u>Section 2:</u> That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the agreement, attached hereto as "Exhibit A," between the City of Coconut Creek and CROM, LLC to reline the water storage tank at 4801 Hilton Road with a ten percent (10%) contingency for unforeseen conditions for a total amount of \$1,031,360.00.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said agreement between the City of Coconut Creek and CROM, LLC.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
