NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

- **Section 1:** That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.
- <u>Section 2:</u> That the City Commission will employ the services of Karen M. Brooks as City Manager pursuant to the terms as set forth in the Employment Agreement, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and is incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.
- **Section 3:** That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Employment Agreement between the City of Coconut Creek and Karen M. Brooks.
- <u>Section 4:</u> That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.
- **Section 5:** That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
