


# LOCATION MAP





#### DRC LANDSCAPE COMMENTS

1. PLANT DATA TABLE: CHRISTMAS PALM, ARIKURY PALM, AND IXORA ARE NOTED AS NATIVES AND THEY ARE NOT. REVISE THE TABLE ACCORDINGLY.

RESPONSE: PLANTING DATA REVISED ACCORDINGLY

2. EXTEND THE PROPOSED WILD COFFEE HEDGE TO SURROUND THE AC UNIT ON THREE SIDES AS REQUIRED BY CODE.

RESPONSE: HEDGE WILL BE EXTENDED TO THREE SIDES OF AC UNIT

3. THE PROPOSED LOCATION FOR THE THREE RELOCATED ADONIDIAS ADJACENT TO THE EXISTING BUILDING ARE WITHIN A UTILITY EASEMENT. RELOCATE PALMS OUTSIDE OF THIS EASEMENT. (EXISTING TREES MAY REMAIN IN THE EASEMENT UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED BY ENGINEERING.)

RESPONSE: THE THREE ADONIDIAS WILL BE LOCATED OUT OF THE EXISTING EASEMENT IN COORDINATION WITH THE CITY


4. IDENTIFY PLANT MATERIAL IN AREA NOTED AS "BUTTERFLY" AREA, WHICH IS THE "CONSPICUOUS DISPLAY OF GREEN" FOR THE SITE AS NOTED IN THE ZONING RESPONSES.

RESPONSE: BUTTERFLY GARDEN PLANT SPECIES WILL BE ELABORATED ON THE PLAN SHEET LP-101
