

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-089

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE A SINGLE SOURCE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK AND FLORIDA SPECTRUM ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, INC. FOR LABORATORY TESTING SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida Spectrum Environmental Services, Inc. (“Spectrum”) has provided the City laboratory testing services, including potable water testing, for the past 20 years; and

WHEREAS, Spectrum has provided reliable services to the City and is familiar with the City’s potable water system; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to enter into a single source agreement for Spectrum to continue to provide the City with laboratory testing services and meet the City’s needs; and

WHEREAS, these needs include meeting the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) rules and regulations, to ensure that the City’s potable water is safe for public consumption; and

WHEREAS, the agreement provides for a three (3) year term with up to two (2) additional one (1) year renewals. The agreement amount will be approximately \$100,000 for a period of five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, single source agreement purchases exceeding \$50,000 require City Commission approval; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds and determines it to be in the best interest

of the City to enter into a single source agreement with Spectrum.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the single source agreement between the City of Coconut Creek and Spectrum providing for laboratory testing services, attached hereto as “Exhibit A.”

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said agreement between the City of Coconut Creek and Spectrum for laboratory testing services.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
