## **RESOLUTION NO. 2016-242**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK FOR A PERIOD COMMENCING ON OCTOBER 1, 2016, AND ENDING ON JUNE 9, 2017; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the School Board of Broward County has established a School Resource Officer (SRO) Program pursuant to Section 230.2319, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the City and the School Board of Broward County agree that the SRO Program provides benefits to the school administration, students, and the community as a whole; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the City to provide police officers to serve as SRO's for the benefit of the public schools located within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City and the School Board of Broward County have previously signed a School Resource Officer Agreement for the 2015-2016 School Year; and

WHEREAS, the City and the School Board of Broward County have agreed that the School Board will provide \$37,001.60 to the City per SRO assigned from October 1, 2016, through June 9, 2017, for a total of \$296,012.80. However, the City shall make appropriate pro rata reductions in the amount invoiced during any month in which emergency circumstances reduce the amount of SRO services provided by the City.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1:</u> That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the attached School Resource Officer Agreement between the School Board of Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

<u>Section 2:</u> That if any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this Resolution.

<u>Section 3:</u> That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
