

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-156

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK PROVIDING FOR A COLLABORATIVE AND COOPERATIVE EFFORT TOWARDS THE DEVELOPMENT OF A REGIONAL INTEGRATED SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING SYSTEM; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, since the dissolution of the Broward Resource Recovery Board several years ago, there has been a lack of regional coordination for both short-term and long-term solid waste disposal and recycling processing services; and

WHEREAS, since the aforementioned dissolution of the Broward Resource Recovery Board, there has been a consolidation and closing of solid waste disposal and recycling processing facilities within Broward County, which has reduced solid waste disposal and recycling options, and negatively impacted County-wide recycling efforts and goals; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek, along with Broward County and other municipalities, procured a study to evaluate potential uses for the Alpha 250 site and the potential development of a regional integrated solid waste and recycling system; and

WHEREAS, based on the recommendations of the aforementioned study, Broward County is requesting that interested municipalities execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to guide the process of developing a regional solid waste and recycling management system moving forward; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the need for regional facilities as well as cooperation amongst the County and its municipalities to obtain cost-efficient, environmentally-friendly solid waste disposal and recycling processing services; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that the City enter into the aforementioned MOU;
and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the residents of the City to enter into the aforementioned MOU with Broward County to provide for a collaborative effort regarding the development of a regional integrated solid waste and recycling system within the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of the resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached MOU between Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek to provide for a collaborative and cooperative effort towards the development of a regional integrated solid waste and recycling system.

Section 3: That the Mayor and the City Manager, or designee, are hereby authorized to execute the aforementioned MOU between Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek to provide for a collaborative and cooperative effort towards the development of a regional integrated solid waste and recycling system.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
