## **RESOLUTION NO. 2021-168**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED STATE PLAN OF OPERATION (SPO) BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK POLICE DEPARTMENT, TO SET FORTH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS WHICH WILL BE BINDING ON THE PARTIES WITH RESPECT TO PURCHASING DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE (DOD) EXCESS EQUIPMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City is currently participating in the Law Enforcement Support Office program, also known as the "1033" program; and

**WHEREAS,** by entering into this agreement we have the ability to purchase surplus equipment from the Department of Defense when it becomes available.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

- <u>Section 1:</u> That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All Exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.
- <u>Section 2:</u> That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached State Plan of Operation between the Department of Defense and the City of Coconut Creek.
  - <u>Section 3:</u> That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the State Plan of Operation between the Department of Defense and the City of Coconut Creek, attached hereto and made a part hereof.
  - <u>Section 4:</u> That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.
- **Section 5:** That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
