

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-026

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAY SAFETY AND MOTOR VEHICLES AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK TO ALLOW THE COCONUT CREEK POLICE DEPARTMENT ACCESS TO THE DRIVER AND VEHICLE INFORMATION DATABASE (DAVID); PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on May 4, 2016, the City entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to allow the City access to the Driver And Vehicle Information Database (DAVID), which was amended in 2018 and is due to expire in May 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City must enter into a new MOU in order to be able to continue to have access to information within DAVID; and

WHEREAS, the new MOU provides for a six (6) year term from the date of execution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached MOU between the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles and the City of Coconut Creek for access to DAVID.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the attached MOU between the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles and the City of Coconut Creek.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part, or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in

application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
