WHEREAS, Daniel J. Agami was a Coconut Creek resident and a Coconut Creek Police Explorer; and

WHEREAS, in 2005, he enlisted in the United States Army and served in Iraq during Operation Freedom; and

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2007, U.S. Army Private First Class Daniel J. Agami gave his life in service of his country while serving in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Daniel J. Agami was 25 years old; and

WHEREAS, U.S. Army Private First Class Daniel J. Agami was promoted to Specialist and was presented the Purple Heart, the Bronze Star, the Good Conduct Medal, the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, the Iraqi Campaign Medal, and the Combat Infantryman's Badge for his service, bravery, and dedication to the military; and

WHEREAS, Specialist Agami is remembered by friends and relatives as a music lover with a sunny personality and, in the words of his grandmother, was "much more than a soldier. He was a leader, a selfless patriot, and a joyous young man with a huge heart;" and

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2008, HR 6338, a bill to honor the life and legacy of Daniel J. Agami, was passed by the United States Government to designate the Postal Facility located at 4233 West Hillsboro Boulevard, Coconut Creek, FL as the "Army SPC Daniel Agami Post Office Building;" and

WHEREAS, a community remembrance of Daniel's sacrifice for his country will take place on June 25, 2017, at Veteran's Park in Coconut Creek where a tree has been planted in his memory.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek, Florida, hereby proclaims June 25, 2017, as

"SPECIALIST DANIEL J. AGAMI DAY"

in the City of Coconut Creek and expresses appreciation for his devoted service.
