I was informed late last week that our Piggyback Contract with Florida Spectrum Environmental Services that utilized the Naples, Florida contract had expired on March 31, 2018 and no other piggyback contracts within the State of Florida were available from Florida Spectrum Environmental Services to piggyback on. This Laboratory has completed our Water Quality Analysis work for many years with no Compliance issues I am aware of and this year is completing the highly specialized Fourth Unregulated Contaminant Monitoring Rule ( UCMR4) analysis for the City with the first round of sampling completed in February and March and the second round would be completed 6 months later. Florida Spectrum Environmental Services has subcontracted out this specialized (UCMR4) testing with Eurofins Eaten, Analytical, Inc. and they have access to the USEPA database to enter the City data. At this time, it is my recommendation to Sole Source the Water Quality Lab Analysis with Florida Spectrum Environmental Services due to the critical nature of the UCMR4 sampling and reporting through FY 2018. It would not be in the City's best interests to change Labs at this time. We would expect Florida Spectrum Environmental Services to honor contract pricing previously enjoyed under the Naples Piggyback contract. Before the end of FY 2018, we would look for piggyback opportunities with Florida Spectrum Environmental Services and if none exist, utilize a piggyback contract with Pace Analytical Services utilizing the City of Wellington contract.
