WHEREAS, community crime and violence prevention efforts significantly reduce victimization and help rebuild a sense of mutual responsibility and shared pride in our neighborhoods, communities, state, and nation; and

WHEREAS, it has been researched and proven that a climate of safety and respect within the home and school is essential for academic achievement and overall health; and

WHEREAS, only a coordinated community effort will put a stop to violence; and

WHEREAS, "Choose Peace Week" is a collaborative effort led by the United Way of Broward County, the School Board of Broward County, and Children's Services Council of Broward County to address the terrible reality of youth violence; and

WHEREAS, Friday, September 20, 2019, has been designated "Peace Across Broward Day = End Means to Earth," and community members are urged to wear green to support this effort.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek, Florida, hereby proclaims September 20-27, 2019, as

"CHOOSE PEACE WEEK"

and urge all residents to join the City of Coconut Creek in supporting "Choose Peace Week" and promoting non-violence in all aspects of our lives.
