

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-121

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO APPROVE A CHANGE ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$49,960.00 TO BERMELLO AJAMIL & PARTNERS FOR ADDITIONAL DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE RECREATION COMPLEX REHABILITATION PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2023, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2023-149, approving a consultant work authorization with Bermello Ajamil & Partners to provide design services for the Recreation Complex Rehabilitation project in the amount of \$182,160.00; and

WHEREAS, the period between the initial completion of construction documents and funding approval for the construction has led to changes, which are required to be incorporated into a revised set of construction documents; and

WHEREAS, Bermello Ajamil & Partners, Inc. has submitted a proposal to provide the requested services in the amount of \$49,960.00; and

WHEREAS, the City has budgeted for the additional design and engineering services, as well as the construction phase to renovate the Recreation Complex Building as part of the City's Capital Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, staff has reviewed the proposal and determined that the charges are reasonable for these additional services; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds and determines it to be in the best interest of the City and its residents to approve said change order in the amount of \$49,960.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached Change Order proposal from Bermello Ajamil & Partners, Inc. to provide the necessary additional design services for the rehabilitation of the Recreation Complex building in the amount of \$49,960.00.

Section 3: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 4: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
