

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-080

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED LAW ENFORCEMENT MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT FOR THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN A BURGLARY/PROPERTY CRIME APPREHENSION TASK FORCE WITH OTHER BROWARD COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23.1225 (1) and (2), Florida Statutes, known as the "Florida Mutual Aid Act," the Coconut Creek Police Department and other Broward County agencies have the authority to enter into a mutual aid agreement for law enforcement purposes; and

WHEREAS, by entering into a mutual aid agreement for burglary/property crime apprehension, the participating agencies will be able to join together to provide operational assistance for burglary/crime apprehension activities across jurisdictional boundaries, critical to the effective and efficient provision of public safety; and

WHEREAS, it is to the advantage of the Coconut Creek Police Department to receive and extend mutual aid in the form of burglary/property crime apprehension activities across jurisdictional boundaries with other Broward County Law Enforcement Agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Agreement shall remain effective until April 30, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission hereby approves the attached Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Agreement for burglary/property crime apprehension among the City of Coconut Creek and other Broward County Law Enforcement Agencies.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said agreement among the City of Coconut Creek and other Broward County Law Enforcement Agencies for burglary/property crime apprehension.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
