

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-140

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED LETTER OF AGREEMENT (LOA) WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA AGENCY FOR HEALTH CARE ADMINISTRATION (AHCA) TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PUBLIC EMERGENCY MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION (PEMT) PROGRAM FOR MEDICAID MANAGED CARE REIMBURSEMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the General Appropriations Act, Laws of Florida 2023-156, provides supplemental payments for eligible Public Emergency Medical Transportation (PEMT) entities that meet specified requirements and provide emergency medical transportation services to Medicaid beneficiaries; and

WHEREAS, Coconut Creek Fire Rescue meets the specific requirements of the PEMT program and provides emergency medical transportation services to Medicaid beneficiaries; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into the Letter of Agreement (LOA) with the State of Florida Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA) to participate in the State's PEMT program for the provision of supplemental payments for the transportation of Medicaid beneficiaries.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the LOA, attached hereto and made a part hereof, between the State of Florida Agency for Health Care Administration and the City of Coconut Creek for the purpose of providing supplemental payments for the transportation of Medicaid beneficiaries.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the LOA between the State of Florida Agency for Health Care Administration and the City of Coconut Creek for the purpose of providing supplemental payments for the transportation of Medicaid beneficiaries.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
