

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-148

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF SHARING INFORMATION ABOUT JUVENILE OFFENDERS WITH BROWARD COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES, THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY, THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE JUSTICE CIRCUIT 17 BOARD, THE STATE ATTORNEY OF THE SEVENTEENTH CIRCUIT IN AND FOR BROWARD COUNTY, AND THE PUBLIC DEFENDER OF THE SEVENTEENTH CIRCUIT IN AND FOR BROWARD COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the “Interagency Agreement for the Purpose of Sharing Information About Juvenile Offenders” (the “Interagency Agreement”), attached hereto as Exhibit “A,” allows for compliance under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and Florida State Statutes, which requires the sharing of pertinent information amongst agencies that deal with juveniles; and

WHEREAS, by entering into this Interagency Agreement, the Coconut Creek Police Department will be able to share information with other agencies in Broward County who deal with juvenile offenders; and

WHEREAS, the term of the Interagency Agreement commences upon execution by all parties and is in effect through June 30, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the Interagency Agreement for the sharing of information about juvenile offenders among the City of Coconut Creek and Broward County Agencies, attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the Interagency Agreement and take all necessary steps to implement the Interagency Agreement.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part, or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
