WHEREAS, Mark D. Bogen was elected to the Broward County Board of County Commissioners in 2014 and was re-elected in 2018, representing District 2, which includes the cities of Coconut Creek, Margate, and portions of Pompano Beach; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Bogen was elected to serve as Broward County Mayor on November 27, 2018, and has served the Coconut Creek community well during his tenure as Broward County Mayor; and

WHEREAS, during his Mayoral term, he championed interests of Coconut Creek and its residents, including limiting Waste Management's expansion of the Monarch Hill Landfill and Florida Department of Transportation's widening of the Turnpike; and

WHEREAS, as Mayor, Commissioner Bogen championed the C-51 Reservoir Project, which will provide drinking water and prevent salt-water intrusion, and with his leadership, more cities have agreed to participate in the project; and

WHEREAS, he established the Mayor's Council, hosting quarterly meetings of all municipal mayors in Broward County to discuss issues affecting cities and the County, which helped foster a more amicable relationship among the agencies; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Bogen advocated for the County to create and fund a gap scholarship program in partnership with Broward College to provide funds to approximately 1,000 students to attend Broward College; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Bogen has led the charge to investigate deficiencies at the Broward County Animal Care & Adoption Center; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Bogen has been a valued advocate for this community and is deeply appreciated for the time and knowledge he has given.

in the City of Coconut Creek and expresses appreciation for his dedicated service to the community.
