

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-190

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE COMMISSION FOR FLORIDA LAW ENFORCEMENT ACCREDITATION (CFA) FOR THE ACCREDITATION OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Agreement is to establish the relationship between, and set the responsibilities of the parties to this Agreement by assessing the Coconut Creek Police Department's compliance with the standards established by the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation (CFA) in order for the CFA to determine the eligibility for accredited status; and by maintaining compliance with those standards by which they were accredited until the agency is re-accredited.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clause is hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and is hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached Agreement between the City and the CFA for accreditation purposes.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute said Agreement between the City and the CFA.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of the applications of this Resolution.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
