6 Visa Credit Card - Preferred Method of Payment

The City of Coconut Creek has implemented a Visa Procurement Card (P-Card) Program through Truist Bank. The City's preference is to pay for goods/services with the P-Card. This program allows the City to expedite payment to our vendors. Some of the benefits of the P-Card Program to the vendor are: payment received within 72 hours of receipt and acceptance of goods, reduced paperwork, issue receipts instead of generating invoices, resulting in fewer invoice problems, deal directly with the cardholder (in most cases). Vendors accepting payment by the P-Card may not require the City (Cardholder) to pay a separate or additional convenience fee, surcharge or any part of any contemporaneous finance charge in connection with a transaction. Such charges are allowable, however must be included in the total cost of their response. Vendors are not to add notations such as "+3% service fee" in their response. All responses shall be inclusive of any and all fees associated with the acceptance of the P-Card. Vendors agreeing to accept payment by P-Card must presently have the capability to accept Visa or take whatever steps necessary to implement the ability before the start of the agreement term.

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Operational Plan – City of Coconut Creek

- An evaluation of each site will be made by our Account Manager assigned to this contract of each site. All sites will be put in chronological order based on location. Types of equipment and crew size will be determined. Services schedules will be assembled and sites will be routed as to services provided. Supervisors and Crew Leaders will assess each site with the Account Manager so they are familiar with each location. A list of all services required at each location will be provided by the Account Manager. Account Manager will review services and work reports with Administration.
- Schedules will be provided to all staff working on this project and services will commence. Work reports will be submitted by Crew Leaders daily, regular site inspections will be completed by Supervisor. Account Manager will submit daily work completion reports to the City of Coconut Creek.
- All services shall be provided as designated in the proposal.
- Account Manager will schedule regular meetings with the City of Coconut Creek's staff for discussions about services and recommendations.



Staffing and Team Structure

Account Manager: Oversees the entire maintenance operation, liaises with city officials, manages budgets, and ensures compliance with city standards.

Field Supervisors: Responsible for daily site inspections, crew coordination, and quality control.

Crew Leaders: Lead landscape maintenance crews, ensuring safe and efficient work.

Arborist: Pruning, diagnoses tree diseases, implements treatment plans, planting, and leads tree removals and relocations.

Tree Trimmer: Responsible for pruning, cutting, and removing tree limbs and branches to improve tree health, aesthetics, and safety.

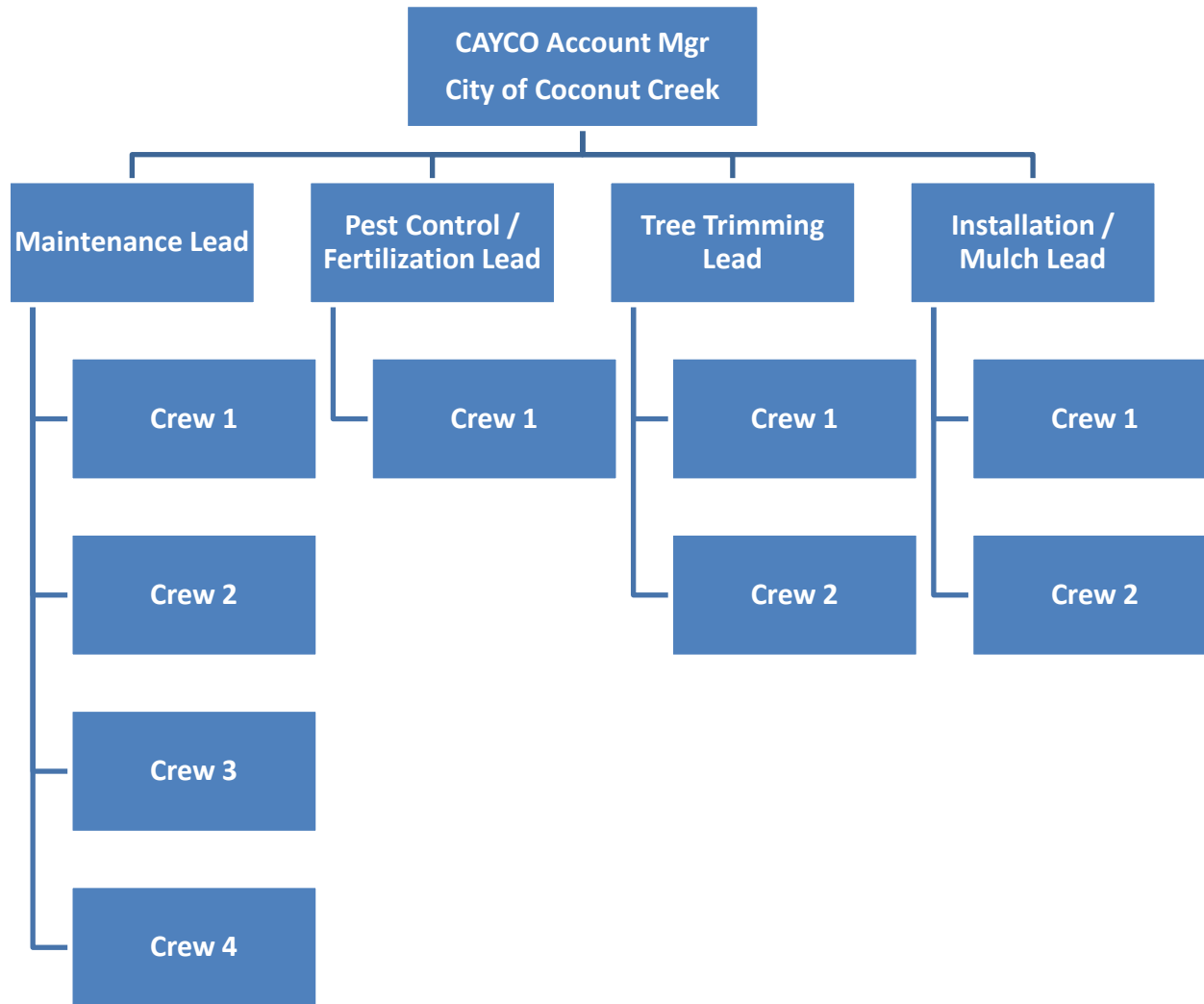
Grounds men: Supports tree-trimming operations by assisting tree trimmers and climbers with ground-level tasks.

1. The following shall be available for inspection at every work site where tree trimming is being carried out:
 - A copy of the company's Broward County Tree Trimmer license.
 - Proof of the company's current insurance coverage.
 - At least one person should possess a current Tree Trimmer training card.
 - Current training cards reflect that training was completed within the past two (2) years.
 - Picture identification issued by a government entity or agency.
2. At least one trained person must be available at every work site where tree trimming is being carried out.
3. The company's Tree Trimmer license number shall be prominently displayed on both sides of vehicles used in tree trimming.
4. Tree trimmer license number must appear in ads offering tree trimming and/or removal services. Advertisements include business cards, telephone directory advertisements, quotes for tree services, flyers and vehicles advertising tree services.
5. License holders shall ensure that all employees engaged in tree trimming are adequately trained regarding safety procedures in accordance with applicable federal and state law including the federal Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 (OSHA).
6. Retraining is required before licenses can be renewed. Tree trimmer licenses are renewable every two years.
7. Each license holder shall notify the County, in writing, if there is a change in any of the standards required for licensure.

4. Neither non-renewal by the Surety, nor failure, nor liability of the Principal to file a performance bond for subsequent terms under said contract shall constitute loss to the Obligor recoverable under this bond.
5. The bond may be executed for additional terms at the option of the Surety, by continuation certificate executed by the Surety and the Principal but regardless of the number of extensions for additional terms and the number of premiums which shall be payable or paid, the liability of the Surety hereunder shall not be cumulative from year to year nor period to period.
6. No right of action shall accrue on this bond to or for the use of any person or corporation other than the Obligor named herein or the heirs, executors, administrators or successors of the Obligor.
