

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-105

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE FLORIDA LOCAL GOVERNMENT CYBERSECURITY GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT SERVICES AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK FOR CYBERSECURITY TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek applied for and was awarded the Florida Local Government Cybersecurity Grant; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Digital Service (FL[DS]) is the lead entity for cybersecurity in the State of Florida, which is administering this competitive grant program; and

WHEREAS, the grant will extend the cybersecurity capabilities to Florida municipal and county governments to improve their cybersecurity posture and resiliency; and

WHEREAS, this grant will provide assistance in the form of services, licenses, or commodities to enhance the City's cybersecurity framework, identify and mitigate risks, and protect infrastructure from threats; and

WHEREAS, the FL[DS] will also provide incident response assistance, when requested, and training, technical assistance, and support.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached grant agreement between the State of Florida Department of Management

Services and the City of Coconut Creek for the Local Government Cybersecurity Grant Program.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said grant agreement between the State of Florida Department of Management Services and the City of Coconut Creek for the Local Government Cybersecurity grant, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
