A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE ATTACHED **AGREEMENTS** THE BETWEEN THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK FOR DESIGNATION OF THE SABAL PINES PARK AND GREENWAY TRAIL AND THE WINSTON PARK NATURE CENTER AND HILTON ROAD GREENWAY TRAIL; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY: AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City applied to the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection for the designation of the Sabal Pines Park and Greenway Trail and the Winston Park Nature Center and Hilton Road Greenway Trail; and

WHEREAS, on September 22, 2016, the Florida Greenways and Trails Council agreed to designate the Sabal Pines Park and Greenway Trail and the Winston Park Nature Center and Hilton Road Greenway Trail; and

**WHEREAS**, the Designation Agreements have a term of 20 years; all the terms, conditions, and specifications have been reviewed by the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission finds and determines that designation of the parks and trails as part of the Florida Greenways and Trails System is in the best interest of the residents of Coconut Creek.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached Agreements between the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection and the City of Coconut Creek.

<u>Section 2</u>: That the Mayor, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the attached Agreements between the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection and the City of Coconut Creek.

<u>Section 3</u>: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this Resolution.

<u>Section 4</u>: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
