

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-008

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR THE BROWARD HUMAN TRAFFICKING TASK FORCE BROWARD ENHANCED COLLABORATIVE MODEL TO COMBAT HUMAN TRAFFICKING WITH OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Part 1 of the Florida Statutes, the “Florida Mutual Aid Act,” the Coconut Creek Police Department and other Law Enforcement agencies have the authority to enter into the attached Broward Human Trafficking Task Force Broward Enhanced Collaborative Model to Combat Human Trafficking Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”); and

WHEREAS, by entering into this MOU, the Coconut Creek Police Department will be able to share information with other Law Enforcement agencies in Broward County with the purpose to identify victims of human trafficking, assist the victims, and prosecute the perpetrators of the human trafficking; and

WHEREAS, the term of the Interagency MOU commences upon execution by the parties and is in effect for three (3) years with the option to renew the MOU upon written approval of the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the MOU between the City of Coconut Creek and other Law Enforcement agencies in Broward County to combat Human Trafficking, attached hereto as Exhibit “A.”

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said MOU between the City of Coconut Creek and other Law Enforcement agencies in Broward County to combat Human Trafficking.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part, or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
