ORDINANCE NO. 2017-023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK BY AMENDING CHAPTER 2, "ADMINISTRATION," ARTICLE VII, "FINANCES," SECTION 2-468, "COPYING AND REPRODUCTION CHARGES;" BY AMENDING CHAPTER 13, "LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE," ARTICLE "ADMINISTRATION, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES," DIVISION "FEE SCHEDULES," 4, SECTIONS 13-83. "APPLICATION MISCELLANEOUS SERVICE CHARGES," AND 13-88, "ENGINEERING," BY **AMENDING** ARTICLE "SUBDIVISION **REGULATIONS,"** DIVISION 5, "SUBDIVISION DESIGN STANDARDS," SECTION 13-236, "PURPOSE: **ADOPTION** OF UTILITIES ENGINEERING STANDARDS MANUAL," BY AMENDING ARTICLE III, "ZONING REGULATIONS," DIVISION 1, "GENERALLY," SECTION 13-293, "OFFICIAL ZONING MAP," IN ORDER TO UPDATE SAME AND PROVIDE FOR CONSISTENCY WITH FLORIDA LAWS PERTAINING TO CHARGES AUTHORIZED FOR PUBLIC RECORDS REPRODUCTION: **PROVIDING FOR** CONFLICTS: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 119.07, "Inspection and copying of records; photographing public records; fees; exemptions," Florida Statutes, authorizes the City to charge certain fees for reproduction of records pursuant to public records requests; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that certain sections of its Code of Ordinances should be updated in order to be consistent with current Florida laws pertaining to charges for public records reproduction services; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds and determines that this Ordinance is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Coconut Creek.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1:</u> That the City's Code of Ordinances shall be amended by amending Chapter 2, "Administration," Article VII, "Finances," Section 2-468, "Copying and reproduction charges," to read as follows:

Sec. 2-468. - Copying and reproduction charges.

The <u>Ceity</u> shall charge the following fees and costs for copying and reproduction services of <u>Ceity</u> records and materials <u>consistent with the fees and costs as provided by Section 119.07, Fla. Stat.</u>, as amended from time to time.

Sec. 13-83. - Application fees, miscellaneous service charges.

<u>Section 3:</u> That the City's Code of Ordinances shall be amended by amending Chapter 13, "Land Development Code," Article I, "Administration, Regulations and Procedures," Division 4, "Fee Schedules," Section 13-88, "Engineering," to read as follows:

Sec. 13-88. - Engineering.

All developers shall obtain approval of plans from the <u>Ceity Eengineer</u> for all proposed engineering work such as drainage, paving and grading, water and wastewater, utilities, roads, sidewalks, seawalls, docks and bridges, prior to submittal of building permits.

A permit shall be required to perform engineering work such as earth work, drainage, paving and grading, water and wastewater, utilities, roads, sidewalks, seawalls, docks, bridges and all other engineering categories listed by the State of Florida and Broward County Licensing Board as requiring an engineering contractor's license. A fee shall be paid based upon the following schedule, prior to issuance. Permits shall become invalid after one hundred eighty (180) days from date of issuance if work has not begun. A renewal fee, as specified below, will be assessed for this and permitted work that has been suspended in excess of ninety (90) days.

<u>Section 4:</u> That the City's Code of Ordinances shall be amended by amending Chapter 13, "Land Development Code," Article II, "Subdivision Regulations," Division 5, "Subdivision Design Standards," Section 13-236, "Purpose; Adoption of Utilities and Engineering Standards Manual," to read as follows:

Sec. 13-236. - Purpose; Adoption of Utilities and Engineering Standards Manual.

- (a) The purpose of this division is to ensure high quality municipal improvements for the <u>Ceity</u> in order that the residents be served by reliable pavement, drainage and utility systems with low maintenance requirements.
 - (1) The <u>Ceity</u> hereby adopts a utility and engineering standards manual which shall be kept in the office of the Ceity Celerk.
 - (2) Design standards shall be in conformance with the <u>Ceity's utility</u> and engineering standards manual, and those established in this division or as required by the city <u>Eengineer</u>.
 - (3) The public may purchase the city's utility and engineering standards manual from the city clerk's office for a cost of thirty dollars (\$30.00) for a hard copy and fifty dollars (\$50.00) for an electronic version.

<u>Section 5:</u> That the City's Code of Ordinances shall be amended by amending Chapter 13, "Land Development Code," Article III, "Zoning Regulations," Division 1, "Generally," Section 13-293, "Official zoning map," to read as follows:

Sec. 13-293. - Official zoning map.

The official zoning map shall be adopted by the <u>Ceity Ceommission</u>. The zoning map shall contain the location and boundaries of approved zoning districts within the <u>Ceity</u>. The zoning map shall be maintained and kept current by the <u>Delirector</u> of <u>Sustainablecommunity Delevelopment</u>. Copies shall be available to the public at a fee in accordance with <u>Division 4 of Article I of this chapterSection 2-468, "Copying and reproduction charges."</u>

<u>Section 6:</u> Conflicts. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances, all City Code sections or parts of City Code sections, and all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 7:</u> <u>Severability.</u> That should any section or provision of this Ordinance or any portion thereof, any paragraph, sentence, clause, or word be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder hereof as a whole or part hereof other than the part declared invalid.

<u>Section 8:</u> <u>Codification.</u> That the provisions of this Ordinance shall be codified within the Code of Ordinances of the City of Coconut Creek, Florida, and any paragraph or section may be renumbered to conform with the Code of Ordinances.

<u>Section 9:</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> That this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage on second and final reading.
