

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-224

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE RENEWAL OF THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE SHERIFF OF BROWARD COUNTY FOR THE DELIVERY OF FIRE PROTECTION AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES BY THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK TO THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS KNOWN AS HILLSBORO PINES AND HILLSBORO RANCHES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek and the Sheriff of Broward County (BSO) entered into an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) on November 8, 2012, for the provision of fire protection and emergency medical services to certain areas of unincorporated Broward County known as Hillsboro Pines and Hillsboro Ranches; and

WHEREAS, the ILA provided for an initial three (3) year term from the date of execution of the ILA until September 30, 2015, and then provided for automatic renewals each year for four years until terminated in writing, which ended on September 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, both parties are desirous of renewing the ILA for a term ending on September 30, 2024, in order to avoid any lapse in the delivery of fire protection and emergency medical services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between the Sheriff of Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek for the provision of fire protection and emergency medical services to

certain areas of unincorporated Broward County known as Hillsboro Pines and Hillsboro Ranches.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the attached ILA renewal between the Sheriff of Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek for the provision of fire protection and emergency medical services to certain areas of unincorporated Broward County known as Hillsboro Pines and Hillsboro Ranches.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
