

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-192

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE USE OF FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$306,608 FOR THE PURCHASE OF POLICE SERVICE CANINE, POLICE CANINE VEHICLE, POLICE CANINE TRAINING FIELD EQUIPMENT, SCANNERS, MOTORCYCLE RIFLES AND ACCESSORIES, BI-DIRECTIONAL AMPLIFIER, CRITICAL INCIDENT COMMAND SYSTEM BOARDS, SWAT BALLISTIC SHIELDS, PRECISION RIFLES AND ACCESSORIES, POWERDMS USER LICENSES, LICENSE EXPANSION OF SYSTEM (64), AND S2 NETBOX EXTREME SOFTWARE UPGRADE; AND AUTHORIZING THE USE OF LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,500 AS A DONATION TO THE SOUTHWEST FLORIDA POLICE CHIEFS ASSOCIATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek has established a Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund for receipt and disbursement of forfeiture monies, pursuant to the federal Department of Justice agreement, and a Local Law Enforcement Trust Fund for receipt and disbursement of forfeiture monies, pursuant to Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has requested that the City Commission make an appropriation from said funds; and

WHEREAS, said request complies with the provisions of the Department of Justice Guide to Equitable Sharing for State and Local Law Enforcement Agencies Agreement and Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission hereby approves the appropriation of Three Hundred Six Thousand Six Hundred and Eight Dollars (\$306,608) from the Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund for a police service canine, police canine vehicle, police canine training field equipment, scanners, motorcycle rifles and accessories, bi-directional amplifier, critical incident command system boards, SWAT ballistic shields, precision rifles and accessories, PowerDMS user licenses, license expansion of system (64), and S2 NetBox Extreme software upgrade; and Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500) from the Local Law Enforcement Trust Fund as a donation to the Southwest Florida Police Chiefs Association.

Section 3: That the City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to proceed with the above expenditure from forfeiture funds.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this Resolution.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
