

With the Butterfly Festival being one of Coconut Creek's premier events, it's imperative that the finished product represent the community of Coconut Creek in the finest light.

With this in mind and a personal requirement of Big Fun, Inc. for all Big Fun produced events, only the finest equipment available will be delivered and operated at the event.

First impressions are everything and the management and staff at Big Fun, are firm believers you only get one first impression.

From the moment we arrive on site, our trucks and equipment arrive clean, to help make that first impression a positive one. We pride ourselves in being possibly the cleanest carnival operating in Florida, with our equipment getting a thorough wash every week after being set up.

When the gates open and the guests arrive on site, they are greeted by our uniformed staff, bright lights and sparkling rides. Exactly what a first impression should look like.

Before the equipment arrives, a strategic layout of the event is implemented.

Considering placement, and traffic flow, rides, and food concessions are located with the goal of keeping crowds orderly.

Consideration is also given to the type of rides. An equal mix of Kiddie, family and teen rides is critical to accommodate everyone. We have rides, for the smallest of riders, entire family's, and those with no fear.

Upon arrival, all rides are placed on location, then set up and given a thorough inspection by our management and maintenance staff. Prior to opening, inspections are schedule through the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, who then send a State certified inspector to perform an additional inspection on all rides.

Upon completion of the State inspections, the rides are permitted and a sticker applied showing the ride has passed its inspection.

Food and games are treated the same way. With concessions providing options ranging from Corn Dogs to Chicken Tenders for the kids in the crowd, and Sausage Sandwiches and Philly Cheesesteaks for the older crowd. Cotton Candy, Pop Corn, Funnel Cakes, and Fried Oreos are on the desert menu.

Bigger is not always better. Knowing the demographics of your crowd and catering to their wants and needs is truly what matters. At Big Fun, Inc. we know the communities of South Florida and what works. It's our home turf.

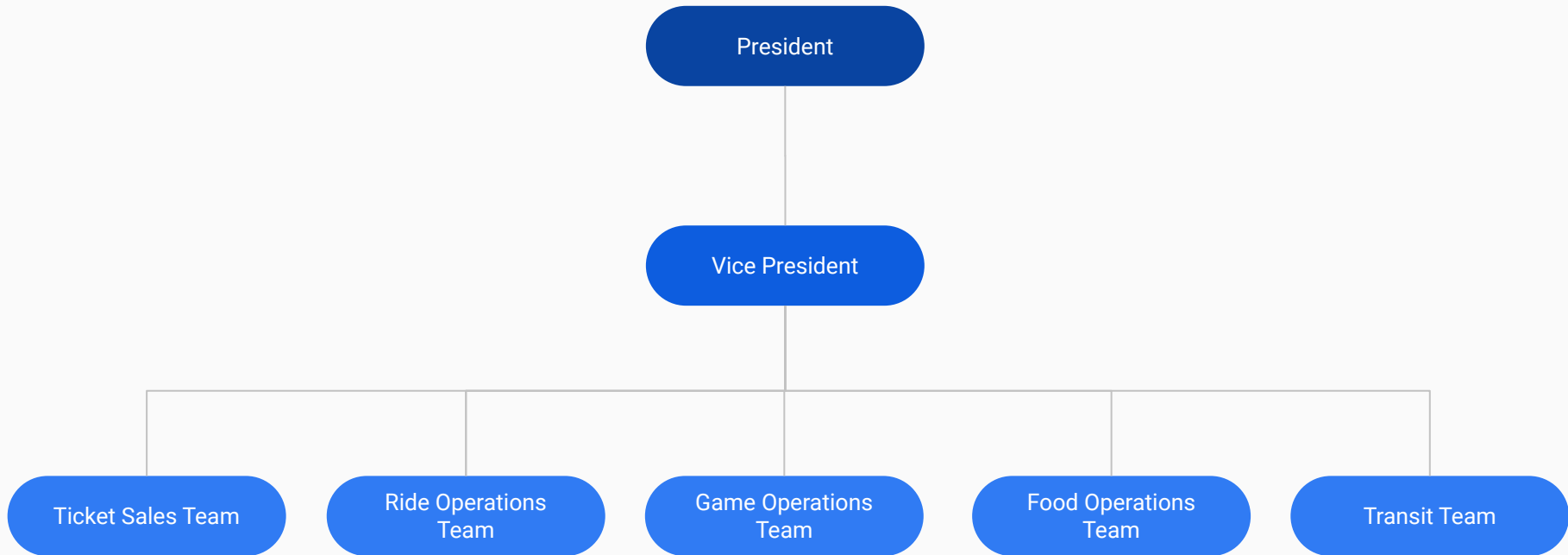

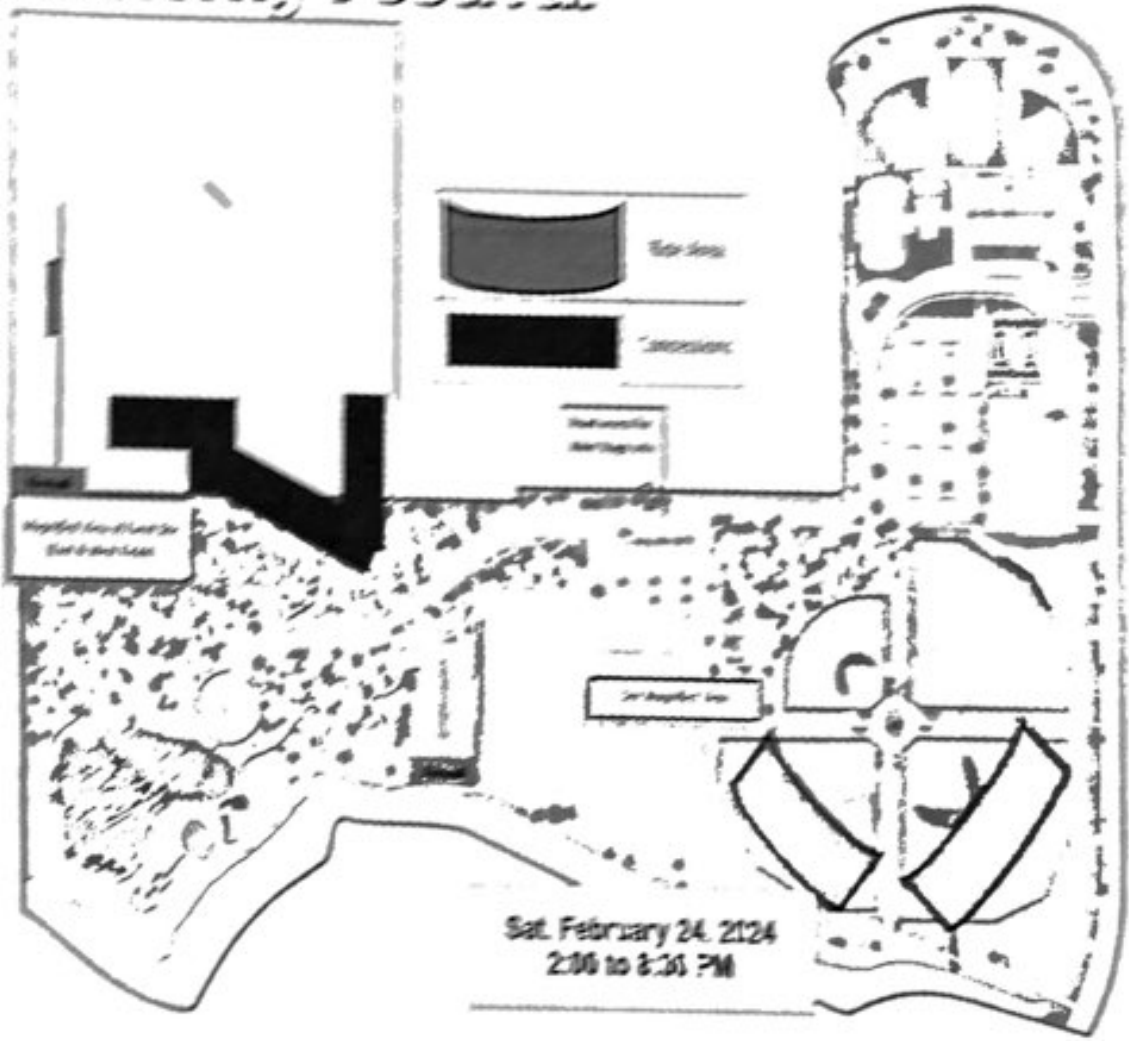

PAYMENT METHODS

VISA PURCHASING CARD (reference informational flyer on following page):

The City of Coconut Creek has implemented a Visa Procurement Card (P-Card) Program through SunTrust Bank. The City's preference is to pay for goods/services with the P-Card. This program allows the City to expedite payment to our vendors. Some of the benefits of the P-Card Program to the vendor are: payment received within 72 hours of receipt and acceptance of goods, reduced paperwork, issue receipts instead of generating invoices, resulting in fewer invoice problems, and deal directly with the cardholder (in most cases).

Vendors accepting payment by the P-Card may not require the City (Cardholder) to pay a separate or additional convenience fee, surcharge or any part of any contemporaneous finance charge in connection with a transaction. Such charges are allowable, however must be included in the total cost of the bid. Vendors are not to add notations such as "+3% service fee" in their bid response. All bid responses shall be inclusive of any and all fees associated with the acceptance of the P-Card.

Vendors agreeing to accept payment by P-Card must presently have the capability to accept Visa or take whatever steps necessary to implement the ability before the start of the agreement term.

EFT

The City of Coconut Creek's Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) Program allows the City to process payments to vendors electronically, directly to their financial institution of choice. With EFT payments, funds are deposited to vendor's bank account and are available the date the bank receives them. There will be no more waiting to receive payments in the mail, and no trips to the bank to make deposits. EFT payments also reduced the risk of misrouting, theft, and forgery. Additionally, an automated e-mail of the remittance advice will be sent to the e-mail specified by the vendor.

PAPER CHECK

Paper checks can also be processed by the City for vendor payments.

INDEMNIFICATION CLAUSE

Nothing in this section shall affect the immunities of the City pursuant to Chapter 768, Florida Statutes, as amended from time to time, nor shall it constitute an agreement by the City to indemnify Contractor, its officers, employers, subcontractors or agents against any claim or cause of action. This section shall not be construed as consent to be sued by any third parties in any matter arising out of this Agreement. The foregoing indemnification and release shall survive the termination of this Agreement.



Big Fun requests the (30) calendar days be changed to (90) ninety. A cancellation (30) days prior to an event does not allow enough time to contract with another event, due to permit requirements, state inspection time limits and negotiations of a contract. (90) ninety days allows for enough time to contract with another event.

Pg 19 Award of Contract. Section 16.1

"the City reserves the right to award the contract to two (2) proposers"
 Due to extremely high insurance costs and coverages, and the potential claims or litigation stemming from another proposers equipment at the same event, Big Fun could only accept an award of the Bid if they were the exclusive provider of the amusement rides at any given event.

Pg 26 Section 111 Purpose.

Big Fun is submitting a bid for rides and/or concessions, but is not interested in operating any of the permanent concession buildings or facilities the City owns. The proposal will pertain to amusement rides and portable food concessions only.

Pg 26 1.a Big Fun will offer a flat fee for the concessions that they propose to operate, versus the 30% listed on the "attached Concession agreement".

Big Fun would like a cancellation option added for the City, as well as Big Fun to cancel out of the additional contract years upon the completion of each Butterfly Festival. Either the City or Big Fun, Inc would have the option to cancel by notifying the other party within 90 days of the completion of the current years Butterfly Festival. Notification would be by email, and certified letter.

Pg 20 Section 18 Price

A firm price shall be quoted for the 1st year of the proposal. Big Fun reserves the right to adjust costs for subsequent years, by providing the City an updated Price Schedule by August 15 of each contract year.

The City at that point would have 30 days to accept the updated Price Schedule, or cancel as outlined in Section 19

Pg 20 Insurance Requirements Paragraph 3

"Further modification of insurance requirements"

The proposal and pricing is based on current RFP insurance requirements. In the event modifications are requested in the future, any added costs to Big Fun by these modifications would be added to the proposal and current pricing.

A cost proposal will be provided for rides currently available. Additional rides may become available at a future date. At that time an additional cost proposal will be provided. In the event a ride is contracted and is no longer available Big Fun reserves the right to substitute another ride of equal or greater value.

Pg 29 Section 13 Personnel subsection 13a (Electrician)

Big Fun will provide an electrician on site during the event and any required inspections. The electrician will be only obligated to electrical equipment, rides and concessions provided by Big Fun.

Any additional oversight or inspections of other parts of the event other than the carnival and concessions will need to be negotiated between the City and the hired electrician, if the city opts to use such electrician to oversee other areas of the event.

Pg 29 Section 14d

All Big Fun rides come with enough fence to encompass each ride, as set by the manufacturer of each ride. Additional fencing could potentially be provided, but line management and line monitoring will be the responsibility of the City. Big Fun and their ride operators can only control the rides and patrons from the moment they enter the ride through the entrance gate and exit, after the ride, through the exit gate. All patrons waiting in line are outside of the designated ride area, and under the supervision of the cities ⁵⁰ crowd control supervisors, security, or police.

Big Fun is not responsible for any damage caused to the property while delivering, locating and/or removing equipment into the park, and on and off the fields, such as turf damage, sidewalks, or landscaping.

It is understood that Big Fun will need to deliver and stage equipment at the park prior to the event, and after the event. All equipment will be staged in the designated areas, as outlined by the City.

The City will provide field lights and or portable light towers during tear down, which will commence upon closing of the event and continue throughout the night until completed. Lights will need to be provided until all equipment is down and off of the fields.

Restroom facilities will need to be open for the duration of set up and tear down. Either permanent restrooms need to be available, or portable restrooms may be provided.

Portable Generators and Power Distribution services are additional as outlined in attached form.


