RESOLUTION NO. 2024-148

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE USE OF FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF FORTY-EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$48,000) FROM THE FEDERAL FORFEITURE JUSTICE FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) POLARIS RANGERS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek has established Federal Law Enforcement Trust Funds for the receipt and disbursement of forfeiture monies, pursuant to the Federal Department of Justice Fund Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has requested that the City Commission make an appropriation from said funds; and

WHEREAS, funds from the Federal Forfeiture Justice Fund will be utilized for law enforcement purposes to purchase two (2) Polaris Rangers; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation of funds complies with the requirements of the Department of Justice Guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

- **Section 1:** That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.
- <u>Section 2:</u> That the City Commission hereby approves the appropriation of Forty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$48,000) from the Federal Forfeiture Justice Fund for the purchase of two (2) Polaris Rangers.
- **Section 3:** That the City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to proceed with the above expenditure from forfeiture funds.
- <u>Section 4:</u> That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
