

WHEREAS, K-9 Noble has served the Coconut Creek Police Department with distinction since November 2020; and

WHEREAS, K-9 Noble has selflessly dedicated his service to the safety and security of the Coconut Creek community, completing numerous deployments; and

WHEREAS, K-9 Noble has played a vital role in law enforcement, resulting in 43 criminal apprehensions, demonstrating exceptional skills and training in locating felony suspects; and

WHEREAS, K-9 Noble's keen sense of smell has been instrumental in locating property found and discarded by the offenders in commercial burglaries and robberies, resulting in the seizure of key pieces of evidence to assist in successful conviction of the offenders; and

WHEREAS, K-9 Noble's exceptional service has been recognized on both a regional and national level, receiving awards from the United States Police Canine Association (USPCA). K-9 Noble and his handler, Sergeant Cummings, achieved the "Top Dog Award" and made history as the first female handler to win a Region 1 Field Trial, encompassing K-9 teams in Florida, Georgia, and Alabama. They also earned national awards, including 2nd place in obedience, 5th place in apprehension, and ranked 9th place overall nationally.
