

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-151

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2020-048 AND THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CORAL SPRINGS AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK DATED MAY 14, 2020; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT IN ITS PLACE PROVIDING FOR THE DELIVERY OF 911 DISPATCH COMMUNICATION SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on May 14, 2020, the City of Coconut Creek approved and executed an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between the City of Coral Springs and the City of Coconut Creek providing for 911 dispatch services for three cities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coral Springs updated Sections 8.02 and 8.03 of the ILA to ensure 911 dispatch services will be provided for both Coconut Creek police and fire; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek is desirous of rescinding the ILA dated May 14, 2020, and replacing it with the updated ILA, attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission hereby rescinds Resolution No. 2020-048 and the Interlocal Agreement dated May 14, 2020.

Section 3: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached updated Interlocal Agreement between the City of Coral Springs and the City of Coconut Creek providing for delivery of 911 dispatch services.

Section 4: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the attached updated Interlocal Agreement between the City of Coral Springs and the City of Coconut Creek providing for the delivery of 911 dispatch services.

Section 5: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 6: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
