

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-190**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE CITY'S BUTTERFLY EXPRESS PROGRAM AND SPECIFICALLY REQUESTING FUNDING FOR THE BUTTERFLY EXPRESS AS PART OF THE COMMUNITY SHUTTLE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Coconut Creek has previously developed a partnership with Broward County and Broward County Transit through an interlocal agreement (Resolution 2014-59) to provide community shuttle service with the City's Butterfly Express; and

**WHEREAS**, the Butterfly Express meets or exceeds the ridership goals established as part of the Community Shuttle Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is seeking additional funding opportunities for the Butterfly Express and therefore has submitted a Broward County Community Shuttle Program Service Application to the Broward County Transit agency to pursue and secure additional funding opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Community Transportation Program provides a valuable benefit to the City of Coconut Creek.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1:** That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

**Section 2:** That the City Commission hereby supports the Broward County Community Shuttle Program Service Application to the Broward County Transit agency to pursue and secure additional funding opportunities for the Butterfly Express route system.

**Section 3:** That the City Clerk is directed to provide a copy of this resolution to Broward County and Broward County Transit.

**Section 4:** That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

**Section 5:** That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
