RESOLUTION NO. 2018-022

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH BACKFLOW SOLUTIONS, INC. FOR AN ONLINE DATABASE MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE FOR BACKFLOW DATA; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City operates a Cross-Connection Control (CCC) program to protect its potable water distribution system pursuant to the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C. Rule 62-555.360); and

WHEREAS, the City uses a web-based system to manage the backflow prevention data, which is part of the CCC program; and

WHEREAS, the City has been contracting with Backflow Solutions, Inc. (BSI), as a single source provider through a City of Parkland agreement, which is now expired; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the residents of Coconut Creek to enter into a new agreement with Backflow Solutions, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1:</u> That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution. All Exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this Resolution.

<u>Section 2:</u> That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the Agreement between the City of Coconut Creek and Backflow Solutions, Inc. for online database subscription for backflow data management.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement between the City of Coconut Creek and Backflow Solutions, Inc.

<u>Section 4:</u> That if any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this Resolution.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
