

**RESOLUTION NO. 2017-113**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, DECLARING CERTAIN CITY-OWNED PROPERTY AS SURPLUS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO DISPOSE OF SAID PROPERTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY'S SURPLUS POLICY AND STATE LAW; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager has been provided with a list of City-owned property that has been inspected and confirmed by City staff to be inoperable, no longer economically feasible to repair, or obsolete; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the City for the items to be either sold at public auction, traded in, or disposed of in accordance with City Resolution No. 2002-134, the City's surplus policy, and Chapter 274, Florida Statutes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1:** That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution. All Exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this Resolution.

**Section 2:** That the City Commission has reviewed the attached list of City-owned property and hereby declares the property to be surplus and hereby authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to dispose of said property.

**Section 3:** That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
