

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-213

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7,620.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT (FDLE) AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK FOR THE FLORIDA INCIDENT-BASED REPORTING SYSTEM (FIBRS); PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek applied for the Florida Incident-Based Reporting System Implementation Assistance Program Grant and was one of the organizations selected by FDLE; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI) will no longer be collecting crime data through their Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) System; and

WHEREAS, in order to accurately report crime throughout the United States, the FBI is changing to the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) to collect crime data; and

WHEREAS, the grant provides \$7,620 to assist with the transition to the new crime reporting system created by FDLE known as the Florida Incident-Based Reporting System (FIBRS); and

WHEREAS, FIBRS is the new system used by FDLE to receive and process crime data submitted by various Florida agencies, which FDLE will then report to the FBI, so crime statistics can be released through the FBI's NIBRS; and

WHEREAS, entering into this agreement will pay for the cost of transitioning from the UCR system to the new FIBRS system to report crime in Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission hereby accepts the FDLE FIBRS Grant in the amount of \$7,620.

Section 3: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached agreement between the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and the City of Coconut Creek for the purpose of training the police department on the new NIBRS system.

Section 4: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said agreement between the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and the City of Coconut Creek, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 5: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 6: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
