

RESOLUTION NO. 2015 - 186

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OF COCONUT CREEK TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK AND THE CITY OF MARGATE DATED OCTOBER 1, 2010 PROVIDING FOR DELIVERY OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL AND FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES IN ORDER TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT FOR ONE (1) YEAR; PROVIDING CLARIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR A REVISION IN STAFFING REQUIREMENTS IN THE EVENT OF TERMINATION OR EXPIRATION OF THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN FEES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek and the City of Margate entered into an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) on October 1, 2010 (Exhibit A). This ILA provided for the delivery of emergency medical and fire protection services by Margate to Coconut Creek in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Coconut Creek; and

WHEREAS, the October 1, 2010 Interlocal Agreement expired on September 30, 2014 and Coconut Creek and Margate agreed to extend the term of the ILA through Amendment No.1 for the term of one (1) additional year (Exhibit B); and

WHEREAS, Amendment No.1 will expire on September 30, 2015 and both parties are desirous of extending the term of the Agreement for one (1) additional year in order to avoid any lapse in the delivery of emergency medical and fire protection services to the residents of the City of Coconut Creek; and

WHEREAS, both parties have agreed to clarify several items from the original contract including response time standards, grant funding, staffing provisions in the event of termination or expiration of the ILA, and adding references to the newly constructed Fire Station 50 and associated staff to be stationed at the new facility; and

WHEREAS, both parties have agreed that an approximate 10% increase in the

existing annual fee, from \$7,379,641 to \$8,123,500, is in order due to increases in costs for providing fire rescue services and the addition of the eight (8) additional firefighters to staff the newly constructed Fire Station 50.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: That the City Commission has reviewed and approves the attached Amendment No. 2 to the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Coconut Creek and the City of Margate for Delivery of Emergency Medical and Fire Protection Services.

SECTION 2: That the City Manager of Coconut Creek is hereby authorized to execute the attached Amendment No.2 to the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Coconut Creek and the City of Margate for Delivery of Emergency Medical and Fire Protection Services.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
