

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-102

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER (SRO) AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK FOR A PERIOD COMMENCING ON JUNE 21, 2021, AND ENDING ON JULY 29, 2021; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the School Board of Broward County has established a School Resource Officer (SRO) Program pursuant to the Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School Public Safety Act; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek and the School Board of Broward County agree that the SRO Program provides benefits to the school administration, students, and the community as a whole; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City to provide police officers to serve as SROs for the benefit of the public schools located within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City and the School Board of Broward County have agreed that the City will invoice the School Board a total of \$27,000 for the extended school year starting June 21, 2021, and ending July 29, 2021, for the services of one (1) SRO assigned to Tradewinds Elementary, one (1) SRO assigned to Monarch High School, and one (1) SRO assigned to Coconut Creek High School.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached School Resource Officer Agreement between the School Board of Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the School Resource Officer Agreement between the School Board of Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
