

**Written Approval of Extension of Sale Delay Period Under
Second Amendment to Settlement Agreement Until October 11, 2020**

This document provides written approval by the County Administrator for Broward County (the "County") and the Mayors of Coconut Creek, Fort Lauderdale, Hollywood, Miramar, Sunrise, and Weston (collectively the "Mayors") to extend the Sale Delay Period under the Second Amendment to Settlement Agreement approved by the County on September 13, 2018 (the "Second Amendment"). The County Administrator and the Mayors agree as follows:


1. Under the Second Amendment, the County and the Settling Municipalities (listed therein) agreed that the sale of Alpha 250 would be delayed until October 11, 2019 (the "Sale Delay Period").
2. The Second Amendment further provides that the Sale Delay Period may be further extended for three additional periods, each for up to one year, upon written approval of the County Administrator and the Mayors.
3. Consistent with the Second Amendment, the County Administrator and the Mayors approve of the extension of the Sale Delay Period until October 11, 2020.

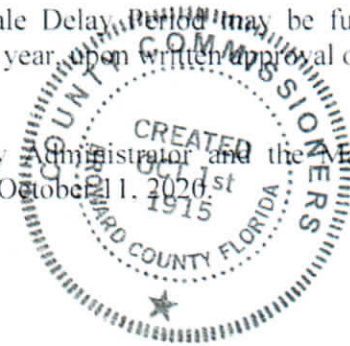

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
