

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-124

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK PROVIDING FOR ADMINISTRATION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK'S COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM FUNDS FOR PROGRAM YEARS (PY) 2017-2018, 2018-2019, AND 2019-2020 TO INCLUDE CDBG PY 2020-2021 ALLOCATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 27, 2007, the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek approved a motion to accept the City as an entitlement grantee of federal funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and the responsibilities associated with that status; and

WHEREAS, the City is designated as an entitlement city pursuant to 24 C.F.R Part 570.4, with a population in excess of 50,000, entitling the City to receive CDBG funds directly from HUD and implement its own CDBG programs; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) encourages the establishment of joint local housing assistance programs, and authorizes local governments to enter into interlocal agreements (ILA) to establish and implement such programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek and Broward County desire to address the housing needs of their respective residents and to promote the efficient location, design and provision of affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek and Broward County entered into an ILA on September 1, 2020, for the County to prepare, implement, and administer the City's

allocations of CDBG Program funding for the Program Years 2017-2018, 2018-2019, 2019-2020; and

WHEREAS, the City and County are desirous of amending the ILA to include the City's CDBG allocation for Program Year 2020-2021; and

WHEREAS, with approval of this amended ILA, Broward County will amend the PY 2020 Annual Action Plan to incorporate CV-1 and CV-3 CARES Act allocations received in March 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds and determines it to be in the best interest of the residents of the City of Coconut Creek to enter into said amended ILA with Broward County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached amended agreement between Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek for the Preparation, Implementation and Administration by the County for the City's CDBG Program for the Program Years 2017-2018, 2018-2019, 2019-2020, and 2020-2021 allocation.

Section 3: That the Mayor and the City Manager, or designee, are hereby authorized to execute said amended agreement between Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
