### **ISSUE: DROP OFF BALLOTS FOR THE NOVEMBER, 2020 ELECTION**

Good evening. My name is Marilyn Frisch, I live at 3949 Cocoplum Circle, Unit C, Coconut Creek, Florida 33063.

As you are already aware, there is a potential crisis in our upcoming general election. This commission is fully aware of the current situation, so I need not elaborate.

As you may also already know, Broward County is considering a proposal to have each city add additional drop off ballot boxes placed within our city during early voting to both ensure the deliverance of ballots but reduce the omnipresent threat of contracting the coronavirus. **Three (3) boxes would suffice: (1) box at City Hall, and (2) one at each of the Community Centers.** Residents can just drive through, drop off their ballots much as they do a water bill.

I am hoping that the City of Coconut Creek pursues this option if available, however, I have come to understand that there are additional commitments which may be required by the city.

- There may be a cost of the secure box.
- The ballots must be picked up each day and delivered to the Broward County Board of Elections just as they would be at BCC.
- Because this involves both Election Officials and BSO or maybe the Coconut Creek Police Officers, there may be some costs to the city. These costs should be minimal, but in any case, I strongly support allocating funds for this initiative if required.

I know that like everything else this Commission does, you will always make the best decision for Coconut Creek. I also want to thank you for vigorously providing information to the community about our upcoming election.
