

WHEREAS, October marks the annual observance of National Breast Cancer Awareness Month, which is dedicated to increasing public knowledge about the importance of early detection of breast cancer to ensure that the National Breast Cancer Awareness Month message is heard by thousands of women, men, and their families; and

WHEREAS, the American Cancer Society estimates more than 316,000 new cases of invasive breast cancer will be diagnosed in the United States in 2025; and

WHEREAS, through research and advocacy, significant advances have been made in the fight against breast cancer, including significant decreases in mortality during the past two decades; and

WHEREAS, early detection – finding cancer before it spreads – through self-examination, clinical examination, and mammogram screening saves lives; and

WHEREAS, when breast cancer is detected early, and is in the localized stage, the 5-year survival rate is 99%; and

WHEREAS, the more than 4 million breast cancer survivors living in the United States today are a testament to courage, as well as the importance of promoting awareness about breast cancer, providing information, funding research, following recommended screening guidelines, and offering treatment to those who are affected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek, Florida, hereby proclaims October 2025 as

“BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH”
