## **RESOLUTION NO. 2024-007**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE 2023 STATE FIRE MARSHAL REIMBURSEMENT GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$600,000.00); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL SERVICES, DIVISION OF STATE FIRE MARSHAL AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, during the 2023 State legislative session, the City of Coconut Creek applied for Senate and House appropriation funding and was awarded a State Fire Marshal Grant; and

**WHEREAS,** the grant provides for reimbursement of six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000.00), which the Coconut Creek Fire Rescue Department (CCFR) will use to supplement the purchase of fire apparatus included in the Fiscal Year 2024 (FY24) Budget.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1:</u> That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

<u>Section 2:</u> That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached grant agreement between the State of Florida Department of Financial Services, Division of State Fire Marshal and the City for the purpose of accepting a six hundred thousand dollar (\$600,000.00) grant to be used for partial reimbursement for the purchase of a Quint fire apparatus.

<u>Section 3:</u> That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said grant agreement between the State of Florida Department of Financial Services, Division of State Fire Marshal and the City, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

<u>Section 4:</u> That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

**Section 5:** That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
