RESOLUTION NO. 2017-286

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING BROWARD COUNTY AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CONTINUE DEVELOPMENT OF A SIDEWALK/SHARED USE PATH LINK ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF COPANS ROAD WITHIN COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAY, FROM JUST WEST OF NW 36 AVENUE TO APPROXIMATELY 420 FEET EAST OF NW 36 AVENUE; PROVIDING FOR DISTRIBUTION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation (hereinafter FDOT) is authorized to undertake a project identified as Financial Project # 436226-1-52-01, within the City of Coconut Creek geographical limits; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said project, FDOT agrees to provide mobility improvements, including the addition of bicycle lanes and a sidewalk/shared use path, along the north side of Copans Road from NW 36th Avenue to east of Florida's Turnpike in Broward County; and

WHEREAS, Copans Road is under the jurisdiction of Broward County; and

WHEREAS, Broward County and the City desire to have the sidewalk/shared use path link installed; and

WHEREAS, the County is willing to maintain the improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to stay involved in the public outreach and design process to assure no conflicts arise; and

WHEREAS, this project is on the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) priority list.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1:</u> That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

<u>Section 2:</u> That the City Commission hereby acknowledges that Broward County and FDOT are to develop plans to construct a sidewalk/shared use path link on the north side of Copans Road from just west of NW 36th Avenue to approximately 420 feet east of NW 36th Avenue, within County right-of-way, to ensure continuity of pedestrian facilities on the north side of Copans Road.

Section 3: That the City Clerk is hereby directed to provide a copy of this Resolution to Broward County and FDOT.

<u>Section 4:</u> That if any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this Resolution.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
