

**RESOLUTION NO. 2015-113**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, SPONSORING CERTAIN NAMED NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS IN THE CITY OR CIVIC ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE SERVICES TO CITY RESIDENTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on October 11, 2011, the Broward County Commission approved Ordinance No. 2011-19, which created the “Broward County Elected Official Code of Ethics” (Ethics Code) and was effective January 2, 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, a portion of the Ethics Code prohibits cities from supporting non-profit organizations with cash or in-kind services unless the non-profit organization is sponsored by a city; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission, in a workshop meeting on September 6, 2012, agreed to review and update the list of non-profit organizations each year during the annual budget process; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 22, 2014, the City Commission reviewed and updated the said list of non-profit charities; and

**WHEREAS**, a need has arisen requiring an amendment to the current list of non-profit charities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the City and in the best interests of its citizens to sponsor the non-profit organizations listed below, which are located in the City of Coconut Creek or provide services to the citizens of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1:** That the City Commission finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the City and in the best interest of the citizens of the City to sponsor the following non-profit charities with either cash or in-kind services, any such cash or in-kind services to be determined in the future:

**Section 2:** That the City Commission finds and determines that there may be non-profit organizations that benefit the City that may not be listed above that apply for the Special Events Assistance Program and meet the eligibility criteria to receive a cash or an in-kind grant. These potential non-profit organizations may receive from the

program not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for a special program event held in the City that benefits our residents. These non-profit organizations will be added to the subsequent year's resolution for approval by the City Commission.

**Section 3:** That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
