

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-201

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND OFFICER ROCCO FAVATA FOR THE PURCHASE OF A K-9; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Officer Rocco Favata is employed as an officer in the City's Police Department and is assigned to the City's K-9 Unit; and

WHEREAS, Officer Favata's K-9 partner, Max, a Czech Shepherd dog, has been retired from duty by the City; and

WHEREAS, it is customary in law enforcement for a retired K-9 animal to be sold to his partner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached agreement between the City of Coconut Creek and Officer Rocco Favata.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said agreement by and between the City of Coconut Creek and Officer Rocco Favata.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part, or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
